Junior Board will help as needed and must work at least 20 paid hours during fair.

Junior Board may have fund raisers during the year to use as needed.

Any member removed or that leaves before their term is finished shall be replaced with a student from the same grade.

Junior Board members do not need to own Fair Stock to become members or be involved in any part of fair depts. They just need an interest in making the fair better.

Minutes shall be taken at each meeting & turned over to the Sr Board for review.

Junior Board must vote on any & all decisions and/or actions with a majority to pass
